





BUTTERNUT SQUASH & FRESH GINGER SOUP



When winter is looming, there is nothing more warming to the heart and soul than a bowl of freshly made soup. This one is no exception. Eat with a hunk of soft bread and butter, put your feet up and savor every mouthful.

Ingredients for 4 big servings:

50g butter
2 large diced onions
1 good sized butternut squash, peeled and cubed
50g fresh ginger root, peeled and sliced
300ml Greek yogurt
300ml vegetable stock
1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
Salt & pepper
Handful of chopped parsley

Equipment: Wand blender

Method: Melt the butter in a large, heavy bottomed pan.

Add the onions and cook until soft. Add stock, butternut squash, ginger and cinnamon.

Cook for 20 minutes or so, until soft.

Set aside to cool for a few minutes then blend until smooth with a wand blender.

Stir in the Greek yogurt. Season to taste.

Gently heat to serving temperature and garnish with parsley.

Plant of the Month

With creamy-white flowers and striking purple spiky coronas, these flowers offer generous splashes of colour during mid to late summer and then afterwards they can delight by growing yellow/orange fruits. Whilst these are edible they don't actually have too great a taste so are perhaps best left on the plant for decoration.

These are great plants for the novice gardener, being pretty easy to grow yet evoke a much more exotic feel than the effort expended. They grow happily in pots as they don't have a large root system—make sure they don't rot over winter as they are prone to this if kept cold and wet.

ZOE'S TOP DIETTIPS

Zoë is asked for her top diet tips so often that she's pulled together a list to whiz over to journalists who ask. You don't need to ask - the top eight tips are right here for you...

1) Don't count calories! Try to eat less than you need and your body will do the following a) make you hungry (this alone ruins most diets) b) but no vitamins or minerals of any value. We store fat and use up lean muscle (the opposite of what you want to happen) and c) slow down your metabolism (this is why so many of you are trying to survive on 1,000-1,500 calories a day and not losing a single pound).

2) Only eat real food – that's food in the form that it is found in nature. Oranges grow on trees - cartons of orange juice don't; baked potatoes come out of the ground - chips don't; fish swims in the sea – fish fingers don't – you get the idea!

3) Eat 3 regular, substantial meals a day – avoid snacking as far as possible. You need to train your body to stop storing any fat and giving it regular, healthy meals is the best way to do this. Don't graze, as so much other advice says – this is what cows do and look at the size of them!

4) The fewer carb meals you have, the guicker you will lose weight! There is overwhelming evidence that it is carbs (and their effect on insulin) and not fat (a key component of real food) that cause weight gain. Watching WHAT you eat is way more important than worrying about how much you eat.

5) Don't eat anything that you crave. We are regularly told to eat everything in moderation - this is madness! Why do we tell alcoholics not to touch another drink and smokers to give up cigarettes completely, but then we tell food addicts to have one biscuit, but not the whole packet? Stop eating anything you

crave – whether it's chocolate, biscuits, sweets, cakes, whatever - you cannot be a food addict in moderation!

6) If you avoid one food for the rest of your life – let it be sugar. Sugar is the ultimate empty calorie – 100g of sugar provides 400 calories, eat approximately 400 calories of sugar per person per day in the UK. There is always a more nutritious way to get the fuel that you need than from sugar.

7) Don't put anything in your body unless you know what it is. Our health (and weight) would be so much better if we always ate real food and never again ate processed food. To get you used to this new way of being nice to yourself, read every ingredient on every packet next time you go shopping. If you don't know what monodiglycerides, maltodextrin or carmine are – don't eat them!

8) If you feel hungry, drink! The chances are that you are thirsty, not hungry. It is estimated that 75% of people are dehydrated much of the time, so they are 'hungry' for liquid, not food. Fruit can be 95% water and even meat can be 75% water, so your body is probably trying to get you to drink.

Colourful autumn walks in Hampshire

The National Trust has unveiled some of the most colourful places and stories in Hampshire ahead of its Great British Walk 2014.

Running from 8 September to 24 October, the Great British Walk encourages everyone to explore the outdoors and discover vibrant National Trust spaces on foot. A vast and varied selection of walks is available, from those chosen by the public to handpicked walks from National Trust experts.

Take a stroll through an incredible landscape of colour this autumn, and don't miss the top colourful choices in Hampshire, many of which can only be seen during the walking festival:

Hinton Ampner: the gardens are awash with colour in autumn, from pumpkins and squashes in the pretty walled kitchen garden, to hundreds of exotic dahlias in shades of cream and yellow, orange, hot pink and magenta.

Walk further afield with the Dutton Estate trail and discover vistas across the South Downs before weaving your way through the buttery-gold canopy of beech woodland. Hinton's Ancient Tree trail tells of Civil War battles, war time evacuees and ghostly hauntings; it also reveals some spectacular displays of autumn colour; look out for the vivid yellow foliage of the black walnut tree and the deep red hues of the Norway maple.

Harvest Hedgerow walk, 5 October, 10.30am – 12.30pm, £10, book on 01962 771305

Explore the hedgerows at Hinton Ampner and discover the delicious delights Mother Nature produces at harvest time. Join the gardening team on this two hour walk taking in the wider estate. Bring a basket or bag to collect any treasures you find in the hedgerows, from rose hips and wild damsons to blackberries. Return to the tea room for a bowl of homemade soup.

Autumn Colour Walks, 11 & 22 October, 10:30am – 12.30pm, £10, book on 01962 771305

Enjoy the full spectrum of autumn colour on this two hour stroll through the countryside around the Hinton Ampner estate. Take in views of the South Downs, and woodland colour and harvest, before returning to the tea room for a warming bowl of home-made soup.

New Forest Northern Commons: Autumn colour on the Commons, 7 September, 10am – 1pm, £5, book on 01794 344020

The New Forest commons of Rockford and Ibsley are beautiful areas of wilderness to explore for retreat and adventure. This ranger-led walk takes in vast tracks of purple scented heather as you walk through these unique landscapes of woodland, heathland, mire and grassland,

shaped by man and nature since the Bronze Age. As you walk, you'll find out more about the National Trust's conservation work in the Forest, and the wildlife that lives here

A downloadable trail covering these ancient sites is also available, taking you across extraordinary scenery and spectacular views that you wouldn't necessarily discover on your own, and revealing some fascinating snippets of New Forest history along the way.

The Vyne: from 8 September to 24 October, a new dog-friendly downloadable walk reveals the hidden history and autumn palette of the estate woodland. On your way to the woods you'll stroll by a large lake, fringed with the orange, crimson and deep purple leaves of liquid amber and swamp cypress trees, which create beautiful reflections across the water. In the woods, beeches and oaks mingle with sweet and horse chestnuts to present a canopy of rich autumn foliage. Listen out for the sharp barks of rutting fallow deer, and keep your eyes peeled for exotic looking (though possibly poisonous!) fungi.

Hidden history walk, every Wednesday, 12pm and 2.30pm, normal admission charge only

The Vyne's new hidden history guided walk takes you on a journey back in time. Pick up quirky and little-known facts about The Vyne's past as you take in the glories of the garden in autumn, including the 'hot border', packed with fiery orange and red floral displays.

Animal Photography Walk, 17 September, 6-8pm, £30, book on 01256 883858

This unique event provides photographers with a rare opportunity to learn how to track animals such as deer at dusk, and hopefully capture some great natural shots.

Note: The Vyne's woodlands have a high deer population, so we hope to spot them, but can't guarantee it.
